For testing children 5 years of age and older, the basic test of visual acuity at distance is the 15-line Folding Chart or the back illuminated charts on either the small lightbox or the big EDTRS-lightbox. In these charts there are two or three sets of symbols in the lower rows so that measurement of binocular and monocular values can be made by using different sets of symbols.

Crowded Single LEA Symbols Visual Acuity Test at 5 feet

▯ The Lea symbols test should be presented as whole lines not isolated symbols, as the crowding phenomenon enhances the detection of amblyopia. ▯ The visual acuity test is conducted initially with both eyes uncovered and then each eye is tested separately by occluding the other eye.

Distant vision testing (Lea Symbols Chart)

An important detail in Visual Acuity testing: If a child's visual acuity has been measured until threshold with the distance test and the values are: right eye 0.8 (20/25, 6/9); left eye 0.4 (20/50, 6/15) it is not possible to know whether the left eye is amblyopic or myopic, except by measuring VA values at 40 cm (16 inches) distance with the LEA SYMBOLS® near test #250800.

In 1993, Dr. Hyvärinen created LEA NUMBERS for visual acuity tests at full and low contrast levels for international collaborative studies and in 1994 they were calibrated against the Landolt C. The LEA TEST VISION SYSTEM includes the LEA SYMBOLS and LEA NUMBERS, and is the only complete vision testing system to use the same optotype across all testing situations.

The order of testing (Lea or Bailey-Lovie E) was randomized across the subjects and visual acuity of both eyes was recorded with the right eye tested first in all children. Spectacle wearers were allowed to use spectacles while performing the visual acuity and the testing distance was 3 meters.

In young humans, the average visual acuity of a healthy, emmetropic eye (or ametropic eye with correction) is approximately 6/5 to 6/4, so it is inaccurate to refer to 6/6 visual acuity as "perfect" vision. 6/6 is the visual acuity needed to discriminate two contours separated by 1 arc minute ▯ 1.75 mm at 6 metres. This is because a 6/6 letter, E for example, has three limbs and two spaces in between them, giving 5 different detailed areas.
